



The Trail of Presidents

Very few small towns can say they have had 22 presidents that lived or visited their communities. We have researched each United States President and have formed a list of the 22 presidents that have visited Prairie du Chien. The Oak tree is America's National Tree. Oak trees are being planted because individual oaks have played a part in historical events. In the annals of military history "Old Ironsides," the U.S. Constitution, took



The City of Prairie du Chien Park & Recreation Department is advising residents that both the Department of Agriculture and Wisconsin DNR have confirmed the Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) in



our community. The insect, which has infested trees **throughout the nation**, **is not a threat to human or animal health** but poses a risk to the community's ash trees. Infested ash trees can pose a risk to public safety due to the fact that their branches become

very brittle and can fall on people EAB tree at Washington St. Park and property.

The City Park, Recreation, and Forestry Department is working with the DNR funded Southwest Badger Resource Conservation & Development (RC&D) Council to address the communities infested ash trees. If you think you have a tree infested by EAB please contact Brandon Bleuer at Brandon.bleuer@swbadger. org or (608) 304-6826. He will assist you in determining your next steps of EAB removal.

PDC State Park

The Children's Advisory Board along with many supporters have added a great skateboard park to the Prairie du Chien Park system. 
